Introduction

The technology expertise required to implement and manage mobility and Bring your own Device (BYOD) solutions can overwhelm a small to medium-sized business (SMB) – and so can the price because these organizations have limited budgets. Therefore, many companies delay technology purchases in spite of the productivity benefits to the organization. Here are some statistics that reflect SMB business owners' opinions on this topic:

SMB Group's 2014 SMB Routes to Market Study indicates that 67 percent of small and 81 percent of medium businesses say that technology solutions help them run their businesses better or that technology solutions help them significantly improve business outcomes.

- According to the Fifth Annual Brother Small Business Survey, a surprising 72 percent of small business owners indicate new technologies will offer a better ROI in 2014 than hiring new employees.
- According to the same Brother International Corp survey, 63 percent of respondents frequently feel overwhelmed with the number of technologies available to run their business but,
- 41 percent of small business owners indicate that mobile devices, such as smartphones and tablets, are the top technology they require to run their business.

This paper discusses the reasons why mobility overwhelms SMB businesses and how Acronis Access can make mobility easy to buy, implement, and use.

THREE REASONS WHY MOBILITY OVERWHELMS SMBS

here are three reasons why mobility overwhelms SMBs.

Limited Technology Budgets

Although a high percentage of organizations recognize the benefits derived from mobility and BYOD, most companies do not put aside an annual budget for these technologies. Instead, they typically purchase mobile technologies on-demand. According to a recent Sage study of North American companies:

- 74 percent of those surveyed in the manufacturing and distribution segments said they do not set a
 budget for mobile technology, even though 51 percent of these business owners reported using mobile
 devices and applications to access work-related materials while they are away from the office.
- 73 percent of food and beverage industry businesses reported that mobile technology positively impacts customer service, but 76 percent of companies reported not setting a budget for it.
- Only 14 percent of those surveyed in the construction industry set a budget for mobile technology despite 77 percent of the companies reporting that smartphones have a positive impact on their organizational productivity.

While these are the trends for organizations of all sizes, it is safe to assume that the budgeting for mobile technology occurs less frequently with SMBs since those organizations tend to have less formal planning processes in place.

Limited IT Resources and Expertise

Small and medium-sized businesses also have limited IT resources. If you own a small business, you may contract with an independent consultant or agency for IT support. Alternatively, you might place part-time responsibility for your systems with a technically inclined employee who has a different full-time job. If you are a larger SMB, you may have several full-time IT persons on staff. Regardless of the depth of IT support your organization has, SMBs are not in the business of purchasing and implementing complex technologies.


