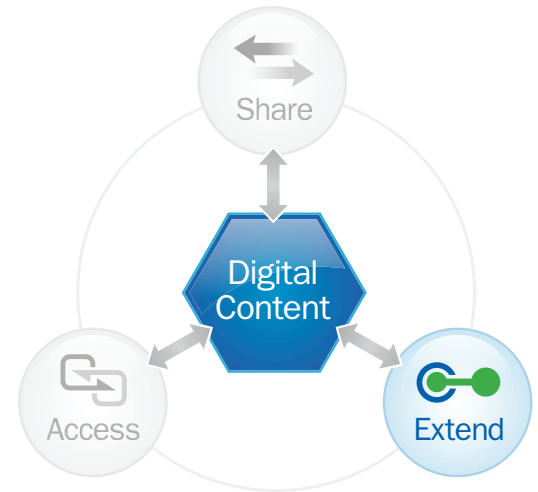

Challenges

Companies make large investments in FSA infrastructures without the knowledge that they will be unable to perform well in a mixed Mac and Windows environment. Macs are unable to access archived files without causing issues because of their unique features such as Quick Look and Cover Flow, which can cause unintended mass file recalls. These recalls put tremendous strain on both file servers and file archiving systems, while leaving many more files online than necessary. The result is wasted storage capacity and a workflow issue for end-users as well as IT administrators. These issues can be avoided by using ArchiveConnect.

Challenges Addressed with ArchiveConnect

- Corporate File System Archiving (FSA) solutions are not always compatible or friendly with Mac clients
- Macs typically trigger the unintended recall of any archived files by simply browsing a folder
- These unintended recalls result in countless large files being transferred to local storage and negate the benefits of a file archiving
- Macs tend to generate a large amount of data. By not incorporating Macs, companies can not capture the entire ROI an FSA system offers
- When not able to access archived files directly, Mac users frequently call IT to help recall an archived file
